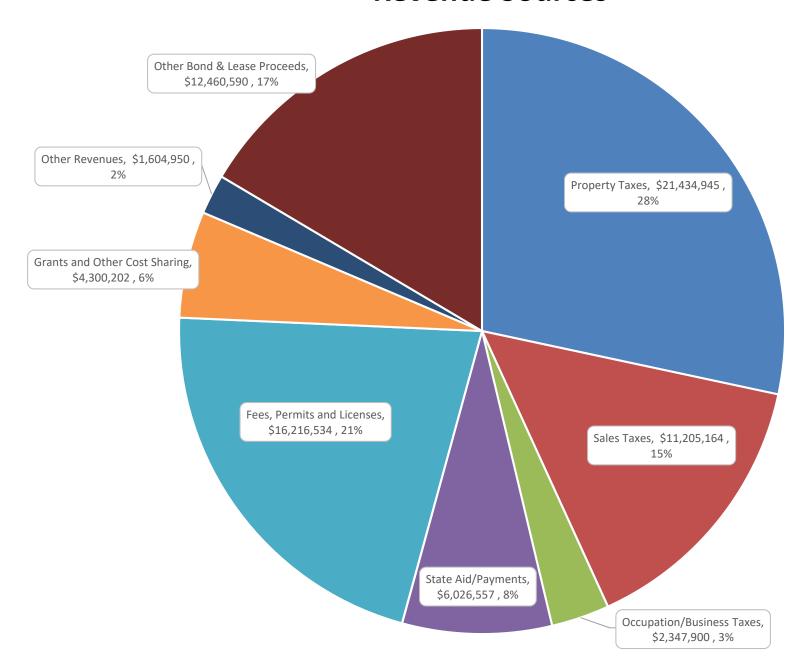

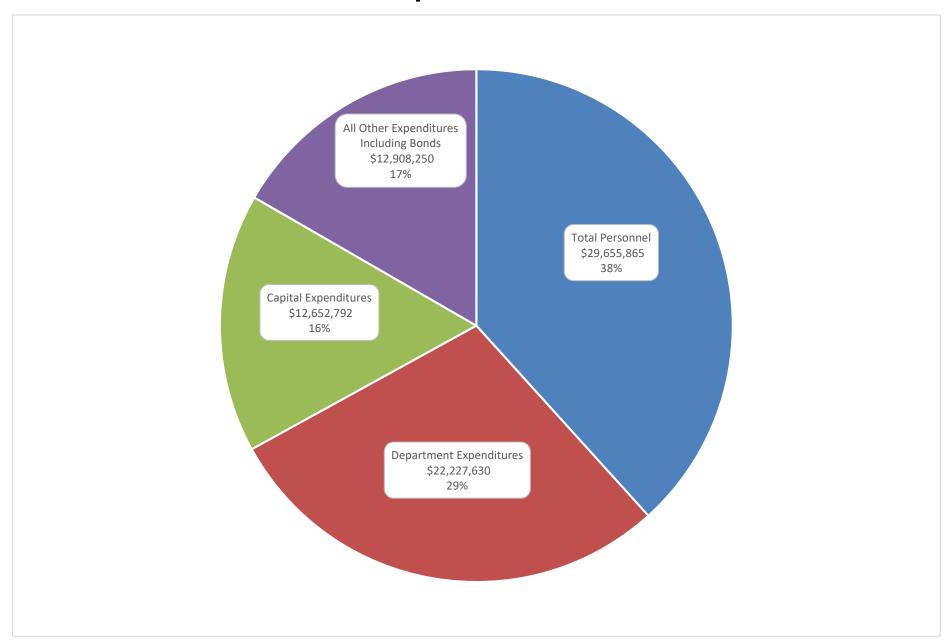

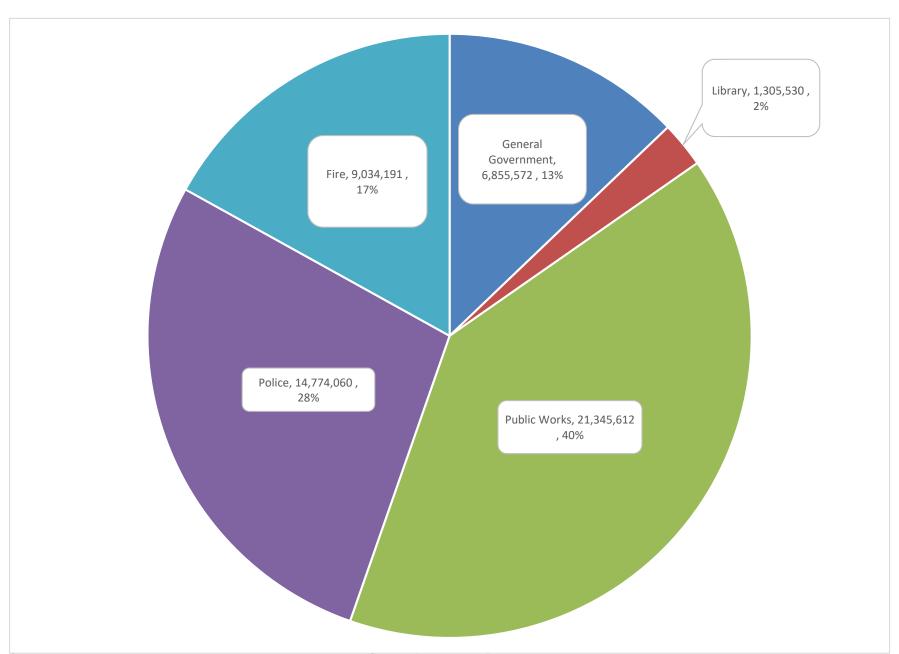
City of Bellevue Revenue Sources
